PRINCIPLES & OBJECTIVES (In increasing order of emphasis)

Balance open space with buildings and structures, to balance first costs and revenue potential of new land.

- Accentuate public-private spaces and granular, non-rectilinear pathways, and provide compression and expansion.
- Use the open space to drive the placement of structures, rather than the other way around.

Stitch together the fabrics of Downtown and Capitol Hill.

• Zone the project area in a way that mediates between the west and east edges of the Lid.

Heal the rift in the neighborhood created by the freeway.


- Reconnect the street grid where possible.
- Provide more varied, multi-modal access and connections to established nodes.

Link a contiguous public path from the south end (connection to Freeway Park) to the north end (Minor and Yale connections) through the C1 site intervention.

- Facilitate moving along and through spaces and buildings.
- Identify and enhance nodes as green spaces into chain of parks, a "green necklace."

Activate the site as a new 24/7 entertainment district. Focus on the pedestrian experience.


- Revitalize and support theaters and commercial uses






YALE AVENUE EXTENSION AND NEW INTERSECTION



NEW MINOR AVENUE CONNECTION OVER I-5




















THROUGH PLYMOU TH PILLARS PARK, LOOKING NORTH






